## **Cave Creek Town Hall Expected to Get Heated Tonight**

Town officials in Cave Creek have invited Maricopa County Sheriff Joe Arpaio and his deputies to be present tonight at its 7 PM meeting when they vote to change laws directly impacting area employers and day laborers.

If passed, the ordinance will appease a community fed up with the number of day laborers loitering on the town's main thoroughfare, Cave Creek Road.

Employers and others have long used the road to find day laborers who help with trade and construction work. The amount of loitering that is occurring now routinely causes traffic hazards, according to the town council.

If the law is enacted, drivers will no longer be able to stop along the right of way to conduct business. Only emergency traffic will be permitted to use the right of way.

The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office is the Town of Cave Creek's law enforcement agency.

Arpaio says his deputies will begin enforcing the new law in 30 days, if it is passed by the majority of council members tonight.
