### **Detention Officer Arrested in Desert Diva Sting**

A 23-year-old female detention officer employed with the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office for just over one year was arrested late yesterday by Phoenix Police and charged with prostitution, Sheriff Joe Arpaio says.

The officer was part of a second wave of arrests relating to a large prostitution ring known as the Desert Divas.

Officer Jillian Lybarger (DOB 10-4-85) was placed on administrative leave shortly after today's arrest. She was booked at the 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Jail and was released on her own recognizance.

### **Three Illegal Aliens Arrested This Morning by Sheriff's Deputies in Employer/ ID Theft Case**

An alert deputy investigating the background of an illegal alien jailed on suspicion of manslaughter and aggravated assault in the death of a 16-year-old Gilbert girl determined the suspect had employment at a Mesa construction company. That determination led Sheriff's deputies to another employer sanctions case today.

Search warrants were served on the personnel files of a business known as SAC-EPC located at 56 South Meridian in Apache Junction (Maricopa County).

Three illegal aliens, including the brother of the man in the aforementioned drunk driving case, were arrested as a result of the investigation and charged with ID theft and forgery, Arpaio says.

"The recent Supreme Court ruling has no effect on our illegal immigration fight here," Arpaio says. "We will still investigate businesses and arrest anyone who commits ID theft. More cases will be forthcoming."
