News Brief for August 10, 2009

A detention officer who has worked for the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office since May 2002 was arrested on August 6, 2009 for allegedly soliciting a young girl over the internet.

Dominic Boulter, DOB 1-10-58, is charged with four counts of possession of obscene material, two counts of aggravated luring of a minor for sexual exploitation, two counts of sexual exploitation of a minor and two counts of unlawful age representation.

He is currently in the Lower Buckeye Jail in an administrative segregation unit on \$20,000 bond.

Boulter is believed to have posed as a teenager over the internet to an out of state 14 year old girl. According to the Sheriff's Office investigation, Boulter sent photographs of himself exposed to the young girl. She reciprocated by sending naked photographs of herself to him via email.
