Sheriff's Crime Suppressions Arrest Eleven More Illegal Aliens in Cave Creek

(Phoenix, AZ)Early this morning Sheriff Arpaio's Illegal Immigration Interdiction Unit (Triple I) saturated the towns of Cave Creek and Carefree.

In four short hours, eleven illegal aliens were arrested; three of them were booked into Fourth Avenue Jail on state charges for failing to provide identification. In the last two weeks deputies have arrested twenty-three illegal aliens in Cave Creek.

"I am seeking voluntary compliance. If they are here illegally, they should go back to their home country. It seems as if there is a loop hole in the media because the message isn't getting out," says the Sheriff. "My deputies will continue to enforce every law and every aspect of the illegal immigration law throughout Maricopa County."

Arson Investigators Arrest Three in Sun City West Fire:

The Maricopa County Sheriff's Office began working the arson of the Dental Impressions Family Dentistry Office in late May. The Sun City West dental office fire proved to be arson by being doused with gasoline and set fire by match.

Deputies have arrested Sara Byron DOB (06/08/62) a co-owner of the business, on arson of an occupied structure and attempted fraud schemes. Also arrested were Donovan Bering DOB (10/24/62) and Zachary Proctor DOB (02/29/88), both on charges of arson of an occupied structure.

During the interviews Byron admitted to setting up the arson with friends Bering and Proctor because of financial issues.
