SEX OFFENDER INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Title I of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006, the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA), requires that registered sex offenders inform registry officials of any intended travel outside of the United States at least 21 days prior to the start of that travel

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS REQUIRED:

Identifying Information

- Full name (last, first, middle)
- Date of birth
- Citizenship
- Passport number and country

Travel Information

- Purpose(s) of travel (business, vacation, military, relocation, deportation, other [specify])
- Means of travel (air, bus, car, ship, train, other [specify])
- U.S. departure date and location
- U.S. return date and location

Other

- **Itinerary details**, including the name of the airport/train station/port, the flight/train/ship number, the time of departure, the time of arrival and information about any intermediate stops, including any cities/towns within countries and points of arrival/departure from each country
- Contact information within destination country
- Foreign travel visa information
